



UNLIMITED Growing Faith report for year 2018-19

Unlimited Growing Faith works with secondary school aged students through Christian Unions, Religious Education and Values lessons and Assemblies. Our work provides space in a busy school day to think over matters of spirituality and morality.

Quality, Outputs, outcomes, impact

- Christian Unions supporting an estimated 75 - 100 young people across 6 schools.
- We did no RE lessons or assemblies this year due to focusing on the development of the mentoring programme.

We do not measure outcomes and impact with formal questionnaires, but observations from the Unlimited team suggest:

- Improved ability to grasp spiritual concepts.
- Improved ability to empathise
- Improved ability to weigh decision making processes

Which will all help in their maturity.
